
Our 200th edition of Connecting Meota

I'm sure I've failed in many


ways, but I take comfort in Christ's promise of forgiveness, and I take comfort in God's ability to take even our most imperfect efforts and use them for His glory.

By the time you read this, I will be in heaven.

But I won't be in heaven because I've preached to crowds or because I've tried to live a good life. I'll be in heaven for one reason: Many years ago I put my faith and trust in Jesus Christ, who died on the cross to make our forgiveness possible and rose again from the dead to give us eternal life. Do you know you will go to heaven when you die? You can, by committing your life to Christ to-day.

Gospel THE HOLY GOSPEL OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST ACCORDING TO LUKE




